# 2018 AACC/SYCL Salary Survey

The 2018 Salary Survey was designed to capture salary and benefits data for all board-certified clinical chemists (ABB, ABCC, NRCC) working in the United States and Canada. In total, 199 responses were received. However, because very few responses came from MDs and ABB and NRCC-certified individuals, only responses from PhD individuals with ABCC certification were included in the final analysis (total n=140). These individuals could be holding multiple board certifications in addition to ABCC, and were split into 133 PhD, DABCC individuals working in the US, and 7 PhD, DABCC individuals working in Canada. Responses from Canada were analyzed separately to present basic salary information (pages 13 and 14), but they were not included in any of the other analyses reported on pages 2-12.

The goal of the salary survey was to provide the findings to AACC and SYCL members so they can make informed decisions while conducting job searches.

All responses were anonymous and state identification has been obscured by regions that were grouped based on cost-of-living. Questions related to income amounts (salary, bonuses and other funds) were all reported as gross income amounts (pre-tax) USD.



















US Salaries - PhD, DABCC
















### Secondary Annual Salary from Secondary Employer (eg. consulting) in US




#### **Overall US General Compensation Satisfaction**


